



KS3 Curriculum Overview - Learning Support

Your child will develop their literacy and numeracy skills in order to access more of the curriculum and aid opportunities for success across the school. Pupils will develop confidence and accuracy in reading for understanding and will get additional practice and support with key mathematical skills.

| Autumn | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Literacy - Pupils will develop reading skills through Fix-It Reading programme, Numeracy - Pupils will develop some of the foundation skills in mathematics, Settling into the school - Pupils will be support with their transition into school, self-organisation and study skills. |
| Spring | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Literacy - Pupils will develop reading for understanding through reciprocal reading, Numeracy - Overlearning and additional support with maths topics learnt in year 9 maths lessons, Careers / support with choosing GCSE options. |
| Summer | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Literacy - Pupils will develop their skills needed for the GCSE English courses, Numeracy - Overlearning and additional support with maths topics learnt in year 9 maths lessons, Preparation for change - new timetable and starting GCSE options. |
