We are delighted to confirm that Redborne initial teacher education is available for September 2025 with the Redborne Teaching Partnership. The Redborne Teaching Partnership is a Lead Partner of the University of Bedfordshire.

Places are available to new trainees in the following subjects:

Candidates will need to pay a course fee of £9,250 but may be eligible for bursaries, details are available on the [DFE website](#). At the end of the course, successful trainees will be awarded Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) and a PGCE from the University of Bedfordshire. We welcome applicants who have GCSE mathematics and English (or equivalent) and science (for primary only) at Grade 4 or above, and a degree – First Class, Upper Second or Lower Second – in the subject in which the candidate wishes to train to teach, or a closely-related subject.

Extra Funding

A Connolly Foundation bursary of £1000 will be available for any trainee who is accepted onto our Redborne ITE programme. A further £1000 ECT bursary will be granted to the trainee following successful completion of the course and also securing a first teaching post in Bedfordshire.
