

KS3 Curriculum Overview - Art

Your child will learn how artists respond to the environmental issues facing the world by exploring a variety of contextual sources. They develop their knowledge, skills and understanding of the formal elements of art and selecting the use of appropriate 2 and 3D media and techniques during each half term.

Term	Year 9
Autumn	Human Impact 1 & 2 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gain an understanding of the genre of Steampunk Build on knowledge of the industrial revolution and the impact that humans have on the environment. Gain confidence and build knowledge and experience of a range of media. Create a mixed media collage inspired by the work of Vladimir Gvozdev. Combine different materials and textures to create a 2.5 D layered collage in response to the work of Cyrus Kabiru.
Spring	Human Impact 2 & 3 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduction to e-waste and the consequential environmental impact. Discuss how contemporary artists highlight environmental issues around the world. Collaborate and make a positive contribution in a team to design and make an e-waste freestanding 3D sculpture. Gain an understanding of the effect of global warming and pollution on coral reefs. Take inspiration from the work of Yellena James to design and create a Batik response.
Summer	Media skills <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Drawing techniques Completing a still life in response to Michael Craig-Martin Printmaking techniques Completing mono, drypoint & lino prints in response to Michael Craig-Martin
