Your child will learn about the German-speaking world, develop their knowledge, skills and understanding of the German language during each half term.

Term	Year 9
Autumn	<p>All about me</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introductions • Phonics • Numbers - age, dates and birthdays • Countries - languages and nationalities • Family and pets • Personality and appearance • Colours • Weather
Spring	<p>School</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Items in a school bag • School subjects • Opinions and reasons using weil • School uniform + describing a picture • School rules • Using modal verbs • Using the past tense
Summer	<p>Sports and hobbies</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sports and hobbies • Using terms of frequency • Media and technology • Social media • Music • Film • Television • Role plays
