A Level or Equivalent Subjects:

To start A level or equivalent subjects in the Sixth Form, you should be predicted to achieve a minimum of 7 GCSEs at grades 4 or above or, for vocational qualifications, merit and above at level 2. Many options will also have subject specific requirements, please see the curriculum booklet for further details of these.

You can only select **one** subject in each block and you **must** choose a subject in **three** option blocks. If desired a fourth subject in a fourth option block may be selected. Please note that the fourth choice will only be offered if space is available in the relevant class/group.

If there is any additional information that you wish to draw to our attention relating to your study in the Sixth Form, for example medical conditions, additional time in exams or learning support needs, we would be grateful if you could indicate this in the box overleaf, even if you have informed the school previously.

Please note the following, it may apply to you.....

- If you have not achieved a grade 4 in GCSE mathematics and/or GCSE English language you will need to retake it in year 12. Please show your predicted grades for English and maths on the back of this form.
- These option blocks are provisional at this stage - if you find that your preferred combination of subjects is not available, then please complete a combination of subjects that does fit and in the 'additional information' box indicate your preferred choice(s). We will then endeavour to take your preferred choices into account and amend the option blocks if possible.
- We are hoping that all subjects should run as indicated on this form but there is a possibility that some will be withdrawn at a later stage due to staffing changes or if demand is too small to make the class viable.
- We will be checking your choices against the predicted grades in the Spring 2019 Progress Checks. You will be offered a place on a course if you meet the entry requirements for that subject.
- Fashion & Clothing is a double option and you must opt for it in both blocks A and D. (this counts as two options)
- Further Mathematics is a double option and you must opt for it in both blocks C and E. (this counts as two options)
- Health and social care can be taken as a single or a double option. If you want to take the single option only you must opt for it in C only. To take the double option you must opt for it in both blocks C and D (this counts as two options)
- Mathematical Studies is a 1 year course.
- The deadline for the return of this form is Thursday 31st Jan but as resources are limited places on courses will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Get your form in early to avoid disappointment.
- **We will be checking your subject choices against the predicted grades given on the reference, which we will request from your school. If your predicted grades do not quite match the entry requirements for the sixth form or the courses you wish to study, we may ask you to come in to Redborne for a meeting to discuss your options and find a way forward.**
